He was a senior leader at an outstanding secondary school for 11 years and senior lecturer in education studies at the University of Brighton.



He is now an education consultant, with a focus on the arts, wellbeing and STEAM in the curriculum; a high-performance coach for senior leaders; partnership coordinator; and both a designer of and facilitator for Institute of Education (UCL) programmes. Stephen holds a MA in education leadership, with a focus on change leadership. Highly experienced in school leadership, Stephen was a governor for nine years, including Chair of Governors and a Local Leader of Governance for East Sussex County Council.

Both Stephen and Joanne facilitated workshops on teaching schools and working in partnership at the East Sussex County Council governance conference. They have co-written books on parental engagement and student learning strategies. They have also given lectures to ITE trainees and mentors at events held by the University of Sussex.
